# From The Desk Of The Executive Director

I am excited to announce new programs starting in April. First off, we are kicking off our new Movie Matinee program on April 12 at 1pm. (Please call the Senior Center for current showing - due to copyright, we cannot advertise the movies.) The matinees are free to attend, and we are hoping you'll help us select future films to watch. This can include new releases along with the classics. Movies will run the 2nd Tuesday of each month at 1pm. Seniors Eating Well starts in April for a free 10-week series on healthy eating, exercise, and ways to improve your quality of life. You Can Draw is a 4-week workshop for anyone interested to learn to draw or expand their skills. The course starts in early May however is contingent on grant funding to start. Birthday Friday with Congregate lunch will now serve fresh-scooped ice cream by our own Advisory Council members each month. Meals on Wheels will continue to receive ice cream like normal.

With the federal emergency declaration set to expire in mid-April and our funding to supply the to-go packaging running dry, we had to make the difficult decision to end the service in March. If this has caused a hardship, call me and we can explore solutions to make sure you get a meal.




# Phone Pols

## **Banana Berry Oatmeal**

This delicious homemade oatmeal feels like a warm hug wrapped in layers of natural sweetness thanks to fresh fruit.

#### *Ingredients*

- 1 small banana, rinsed and peeled
- ½ cup Old Fashioned Oats
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- Sprinkle of ground nutmeg and/or clove
- 1 cup milk (cow's milk or soy milk preferred for protein content)
- 1-2 Tablespoons nuts (such as pecans, walnuts, slivered almonds, pistachios, hazelnuts or peanuts)
- ¼ cup fresh berries, whole or sliced (such as blueberries, blackberries, raspberries or strawberries)

#### **Instructions**

- 1. Mash banana in a medium-size, microwave-safe bowl.
- 2. Add oats, spices and milk. Mix well.
- 3. Fold in nuts.
- 4. Microwave 2 to 3 minutes, stirring half-way through. Time varies depending on microwave strength— keep a watchful eye on the oatmeal, so nothing boils out of the bowl.
- 5. Stir in berries and let sit for 1 to 2 minutes. Enjoy!
