



New Medicare Cards

If you have Medicare, you can protect your identity and help prevent health care fraud by guarding your Medicare card like you would a credit card.

Identity theft from stolen Medicare numbers is becoming more common. Medicare is helping by removing Social Security numbers from Medicare cards and replacing them with a new, unique number for each person with Medicare. This will decrease your vulnerability to identity theft. Medicare is mailing new Medicare cards with the new numbers between April 2018 and April 2019.

The new Medicare number/card won't change Medicare benefits. If you have Medicare, you may start using your new Medicare card as soon as you receive it. After you receive your new card, destroy your old Medicare card. The effective date of the new cards, like the old cards, is the date you were or are eligible for Medicare.

Tips for Protecting Yourself

Here are some important steps you can take to protect yourself from the identity theft that can lead to health care fraud:

Don't share or confirm your Medicare or Social Security number with anyone who contacts you by telephone, email or in person unless you've given them permission in advance. Medicare will NEVER contact you (unless you ask them to) to ask for your Medicare number or other personal information or to send you a new card. Medicare already has your information.

Don't ever let anyone borrow or pay to use your Medicare number.

There is no charge for the new card, so don't pay anyone to send it to you.

Review your Medicare Summary Notices or Explanation of Benefits to be sure you and Medicare or your insurance company are only being charged for actual items and services you received.

Your new Medicare card will be sent automatically by mail to the address on file with Social Security. To update it: visit ssa.gov/myaccount or call Social Security at 1-800-772-1213 (TTY: 1-800-325-0778).


